Kushmanda Jay Jag Sukhdani. Mujh Par Daya Karo Maharani..

Meaning: Hail to Mother Kushmanda who gives happiness to everyone. O Mother Kushmanda!! Now please have mercy on this devotee of yours and save him.

Pingla Jwalamukhi Nirali. Shakambari Maa Bholi Bhali..

Meaning: Mother Kushmanda resides in our Surya Nadi which is also called the Nadi of Hatha Yoga. She works to strengthen the Surya Nadi. In the form of Shakambhari Mata, her form is very innocent.

Lakhon Naam Nirale Tere. Bhakt Kai Matwale Tere..

Meaning: Mother Kushmanda has millions of names and accordingly she has many forms. Her devotees roam around intoxicated in devotion to the mother.

Bhima Parvat Par Hai Dera. Svikaro Pranam Ye Mera..

Meaning: Mother Kushmanda is present on Bhima mountain in the form of Shakambhari Mata and from there she saves her devotees. O Kushmanda Maa!! Now please accept the salutations of your devotee and do good to him.

Maa Ke Man Mein Mamta Bhari. Kyon Na Sunegi Araj Hamari.

Tere Dar Par Kiya Hai Dera.

Door Karo Maa Sankat Mera..

Meaning: I have camped outside your temple and am worshipping you. Now please remove the troubles in my life and save me.

Mere Karaj Poore Kar Do.
Mere Tum Bhandare Bhar Do..
