Maa Kushmanda Stotra

|| Dhyān Mantra ||

**Vande Vanchhit Kamarthe Chandrarghakrit Shekharam.
Simharudha Ashtabhuja Kushmanda Yashasvinim..**

Meaning - To obtain the desired benefits, I worship Mother Kushmanda, who is the fulfiller of all tasks, has a half-moon on her head, rides on a lion, has eight arms and bestows fame.

**Bhasvar Bhanu Nibham Anahat Sthitam Chaturth Durga Trinetrām.
Kamandalu, Chaap, Baan, Padma Sudhakalash, Chakra, Gada, Japvati
Dharam..**

Meaning - It is Kushmanda Mata who provides brightness to the Sun. She resides in the Anahat Chakra of our body and strengthens it. She is the fourth form of Durga Mata who has three eyes. She is holding a kamandal, bow, arrow, lotus flower, urn, chakra and mace in her eight arms.

**Patambar Paridhanam Kamaniyam Mriduhasya Nanalkar Bhushitam.
Manjir, Haar, Keyur, Kinkini Ratnakundal, Manditam..**

Meaning - She is wearing yellow coloured clothes in which she looks desirable. There is a faint smile on her face. She has adorned herself with many types of ornaments. She has adorned herself with manjir, necklace, bangles, kinkini and earrings studded with gems.

**Prafulla Vadanam Charu Chibukam Kant Kapolam Tung Kucham.
Komalangi Smeramukhi Shrikanti Nimnabh Nitamabnim..**

Meaning - I worship Kushmanda Devi by meditating on her feet. Her cheeks are very soft and beautiful. Every part of her body is soft, her face is full of affection, her navel is in the middle of her body which makes her appearance very beautiful.

Meaning - Goddess Kushmanda is the most beautiful in this world. She is the one who removes our sorrows and takes away our grief. It is only by the grace of Goddess Kushmanda that we attain supreme bliss. I salute Goddess Kushmanda .

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
