Batupatri He Shyama, Sur Valli He Gramya. Vishnupriye Jo Tumko Seve So Nar Tar Jata..

Meaning: One of her names is Shyama who is the daughter of a child and she resides in every house i.e. we all have a Tulsi plant in our house. She is very dear to <u>Lord Vishnu</u> and any person who does the Aarti of Tulsi Mata crosses the ocean of existence.

Hari Ke Sheesh Virajat Tribhuvan Se Ho Vandit.
Patitjanon Ki Tarini Tum Ho Vikhyata..

Meaning: <u>Tulsi Mata</u> is offered on the head of Shri Hari and she is worshiped in all three worlds. Tulsi Mata, who protects everyone's married life, is famous everywhere.

Leker Janm Vijan Mein, Aayi Divya Bhavan Mein. Manav Lok Tumhi Se Sukh Sampatti Pata..

Meaning: Tulsi Mata blessed everyone by taking birth in this human world and her house is filled with divine light. This human world receives all kinds of happiness and prosperity only by the grace of Tulsi Mata.

Hari Ko Tum Ati Pyari Tum Shyamvarn Sukumari. Prem Ajab Hai Unka Tumse Kaisa Nata..

Meaning: Tulsi Mata is very dear to Shri Hari and her complexion is dark. She is delicate. Shri Hari's love for Tulsi Mata is very amazing and we all have a motherly relationship with her.
