Meaning: By paying obeisance at the feet of the Gurus and meditating on the devotee Hanuman, the devotee writes Balaji Chalisa keeping in mind the feeling of affection and well-being. It is known throughout the world that Hanuman removes the troubles of his devotees and gives them his blessings. His Balaji form has appeared in Mehandipur.

Meaning: Hail Balaji, the child form of Hanuman ji. All the three gods have appeared in Mehandipur, whom we know as Pretaraj, Bhairav and Balaji. Their Kotwal and Captain is Balaji. He has incarnated in Mehandipur and saved his devotees. He has appeared here in his child form and devotees from far and wide come here to get their troubles solved.

**Daakani shaakani aru jindani, mashaan chudai bhoot bhootani I
Jaake bhay te sab bhag jaate, syaane bho pe yahaan ghabrate I**

**Chauki bandhan sab kat jaate, doot mile aanand manaate I

Meaning: By coming here, all kinds of troubles are averted from the devotees and the shadow of witches, ghosts and evil spirits is removed from them. The evil forces fear Lord Balaji and run away from there. Here all kinds of bondages are broken and his devotees experience bliss. Your court is true and whoever comes to your refuge, he gets the ultimate happiness.

Adbhut kala dikhayi kaisi, Kalyug jyoti jalaai jaisi I**

Meaning: Balaji's form is extremely radiant and Shri Ram and Mata Sita reside in his heart. The aura of the gem adorning his crown is very bright and he fulfils the hopes of all people. Mahant Ganeshpuri is painted in the colour of Ram and praises him. Balaji has saved the devotees by showing his talent in Kaliyug.

Meaning: Balaji 's flag is flying the highest in the sky and his golden urn is also the most elevated in this world. Because of him, Dharma and truth have won and everywhere is the rule of Mata Sita, Shri Ram and Lord Shankar. He has beaten the ghosts with his horse. Shri Ram, Laxman and Mata Sita reside in Balaji's heart and he has appeared in Mehandipur in the form of a child.

Meaning: O Hanuman Ji ! We serve you with our family. We offer you laddu, churma, sugar candy and dry fruits and pray to you. Please have mercy on all of us and remove our troubles. Crores of devotees come to your court and praise you.

**Bal samay Ravi bhakshahi leenha, timir may jag keenho teenha I
Devan vinati ki ati bhari, chaand diyo Ravi kasht nihaari I
Laanghi udadhi Siya sudhi laaye, Lakshman hit Sanjeevan laaye I
Ramaanuj pran divakar, Shankar suvan Maa Anjani chaakar I**

Meaning: In your childhood form, you had taken the Sun God in your mouth due to which darkness had spread everywhere. Then, on the request of the Gods, you had freed them from bondage. You had crossed the ocean and brought the address of Mother Sita and had saved the life of Lakshman by bringing Sanjivani herb. O

incarnation of Shankar and son of Mother Anjani! You had saved the life of Lakshman, younger brother of Shri Ram.

Siya Ram ke praan piyare, Jab Baba ki bhakt uchaare I

Meaning: O Kesari Putra Hanuman! You destroy the sorrows of all, you have always given happiness to Shri Ram. You are dearer to Siyaram than life and Jai to you. You are the destroyer of troubles and sorrows and now please show mercy to your devotees. We meditate on your child form and now please fulfill all our desires.

Meva aru mishtaan praveena, Bhent chadhaven dhani aru deena I
Nrytia kare nit nyaare nyaare, Riddhi Siddhiyaan jaake dvaare I
Arji ka aadesh milte hi, Bhairav Bhoot pakadate tabahi I**

Meaning: You give eight siddhis and nine nidhis to your devotees. Both the rich and the poor offer you dry fruits, sweets etc. You perform various types of dances in bliss and Riddhi-Siddhi are your maids. Bhairav Baba catches the ghosts as soon as he gets your order.

Chauki bandhan katate bhai, Jo jan karte hain sevakaai I
Ramdas bal bhagwanta, Mehandipur pragate Hanumanta I
Jo jan Balaji mein aate, Janam janam ke paap nashaate I**

Meaning: Pretaraj Baba present here does welfare of all. All the bonds of the devotees who serve you are broken. You are the servant of Shri Ram and you have taken incarnation in Mehandipur. All the sins of the people who visit Balaji Dham are destroyed.

Whoever recites Balaji Chalisa seven times, you become very happy with him.
