Shri Balaji Aarti

Om Jai Hanumat Veera Swami Jai Hanumat Veera, Sankat Mochan Swami Tum Ho Randheera. Om.

Meaning: O Devotee Hanuman, Incarnation Of Lord Shiva! You Are Very Powerful, You Are The Master Of Us All And We Salute You. You Remove All Troubles And Are Victorious In The Battlefield.

> Pawan-Putra Anjani-Sut Mahima Ati Bhari, Dukh Daridra Mitao Sankat Sabhari. Om.

Meaning: You Are The Son Of The Wind God And Were Born From The Womb Of Mother Anjani. You Remove All Our Sufferings, Poverty, And Troubles.

Bal Samay Mein Tumne Ravi Ko Bhaksh Liyo, Devan Stuti Keenhi Tab Hi Chhod Diyo. Om.

Meaning: In Your Childhood, You Swallowed The Sun And Released It Only After The Gods Prayed To You.

Kapi Sugriv Ram Sang Maitri Karwayi, Bali Bali Maray Kapisehin Gaddi Dilwayi. Om.

Meaning: In The Form Of A Monkey, You Introduced Sugriva, The Exiled Younger Brother Of King Bali, To Lord Rama. As A Result, Sugriva Regained The Throne Of Kishkindha.

Jari Lank Ko Le Sia Ki Sudhi Vanar Harshaye, Karaj Kathin Sudhare Raghuwar Man Bhaye. Om.

Meaning: You Crossed The Ocean And Found Mother Sita, Burning Down Lanka. This Was A Very Difficult Task, But You Did It And Won The Heart Of Lord Rama.

Shakti Lagi Lakshman Ke Bhari Soch Bhayo, Lay Sanjeevan Booti Dukh Sab Door Kiyo. Om.

 Meaning: During The Battle Between Lakshman And Meghnad, Lakshman Was Hit By Meghnad's Shaktiban And Fell Unconscious. There Was Chaos Among The Monkey Army. Then, On The Advice Of The Healer Sushen, You Flew Faster Than The Wind And Brought The Sanjeevani Herb To Save Lakshman's Life.

Le Patal Ahiravan Jabhi Paithi Gayo, Tahi Mari Prabhu Laye Jai Jaikaar Bhayo. Om.

Meaning: When The Demon Ahiravan Kidnapped Lord Rama And Lakshman And Took Them To The Netherworld, You Freed Them By Killing Ahiravan With Your Panchmukhi (Five-Faced) Form.

Ghaate Mehandipur Mein Shobhit Darshan Ati Bhari, Mangal Aur Shanichar Mela Hai Jari. Om.

Meaning: You Manifested In Mehandipur, Rajasthan, And Devotees Come From Far And Wide To See You. There Is A Fair Every Tuesday And Saturday.

Shri Balaji Ki Aarti Jo Koi Nar Gaave, Kahat Indra Harshit Man Vanchhit Phal Paave. Om.

Meaning: Whoever Sincerely Sings The Aarti Of Lord Balaji, Indra Says, Will Attain Their Desired Results With A Joyful Heart.
