Dekh Chhavi Balihari Main Jaun.**

**Meaning –** “The peacock crown rests on the head of the beloved Shri Krishna , and his lovely flute captivates my mind. I am ready to sacrifice myself on seeing his image.”

**Charanon Se Nikli Ganga Pyari,  
Jisne Saari Duniya Taari.  
Main Un Charanon Ke Darshan Paun.**

**Meaning –** “My beloved Mother Ganga has originated from the lotus feet of the Lord who has purified the whole world. I want to see her feet.”

**Daas Anath Ke Nath Aap Ho,  
Dukh Sukh Jeevan Pyare Saath Aap Ho.  
Hari Charanon Mein Sheesh Jhukaun.**

**Meaning –** “You are the lord of the slaves and orphans, with you we have happiness and sorrow in our life. We always bow at your feet.”

Mere Mohan Jeevan Dhan Ho.
