SHRI BATUKA BHAIRAVA CHALISA || श्री बटुक भैरव चालीसा ||

Vishwanath ko sumari man, dhar Ganesh ka dhyan I
Bhairav chaalisa padhun, kripa karhu bhagwan I I
Batuknath Bhairav bhaju, Shri Kali ke laal I
Chitarmal par kar kripa, Kashi ke kutwaal I I

Meaning: After remembering Lord Vishwanath and meditating on Lord Ganesha, I recite Batuk Bhairav Chalisa. O Bhairav Baba, please shower your blessings on me. O son of Kali, I recite Batuknath Bhairav Chalisa. O Kotwal of Kashi! Shower your blessings on this Chitramal.

Jai Jai Shri Kali ke lala, raho das par sada dayala I

Meaning: O son of Kali, victory to you, victory to you. Always keep your blessings on this servant of yours.

Bhairav bhishan bheem kapali, krodhvant lochan mein laali I

Meaning: Bhairava Baba's form is extremely fierce, angry and red in colour.

Kar trishool hai kathin karaala, gal mein Prabhu mundan ki maala I

Meaning: He holds a trident in his hands and a garland of skulls of demons around his neck

Krishna roop tan varn vishaala, peekar mad rahta matwaala I

Meaning: His complexion is dark like Krishna's and he remains inebriated after drinking liquor.

Rudra Batuk bhaktan ke sangi, Pretmath Bhutesh bhujangi I

Meaning: His Rudra form named Batuk always stays with his devotees. He is the king of ghosts, Shiva and Bhujang.

Trail tesh hai naam tumhara, chakra tund Amresh pyara I

Meaning: One of his names is Trail Tesh and he is Chakratunda Amresh Piyara.

Shekharchandra kapal viraaje, swan savaari pai Prabhu gaaje I

Meaning: The moon adorns his head and he rides a dog.

Shiv Nakulesh Chand ho Swami, Baijnath Prabhu namo namaami I

Meaning: He is Shiva, Nakulesh, Chand and also the master of all of us. We bow to that Baijnath Prabhu.

Ashwanath krodhesh bakhaane, Bhairon kaal jagat ne jaane I

Meaning: Everyone praises that Ashvanath and the lord of anger and the entire world knows the glory of Bhairon Baba.

Gayatri kahain nimish digambar, Jagannath unnat aadhambar I

Meaning: Gayatri Mata tells Digambara about him that he is the Lord of the world.

Kshetrapaal dashapani kahaaye, Manjul Umanand kahalaaye I

Meaning: He is also known by the names Kshetrapal, Dashpani, Manjul, Umanand etc.

Chakranath bhakton hitkaari, Kahain Tryambak sab nar naari I

Meaning: He protects the interests of all devotees in the form of Chakranath and all human beings also know Him by the name of Tryambaka.

Sanhaarak sunand tav naama, Karahu bhakt ke poorn kaama I

Meaning: Because of killing the wicked, his name is known everywhere and he fulfils all the tasks of his devotees.

Nath pishaachan ke ho pyaare, Sankat metahu sakal hamaare I

Meaning: Bhairav Baba is loved by ghosts and demons and removes all the troubles of all of us.

Krityayu sundar aananda, Bhakt janan ke kaatu phanda I

Meaning: He grants long life, beauty and happiness to all of us and removes all the sufferings of his devotees.

Kaaran lamb aap bhay bhanjan, Namu Nath jai janman ranjan I

Meaning: He removes the fear of his devotees and the mind feels joy just by remembering his name.

Ho tum dev triloachan naatha, Bhakt charan mein naavat maatha I

Meaning: He is the Lord of the three worlds and all the devotees bow their heads at his feet.

Tum ashataam Rudra ke laala, Mahaakaal kalon ke kaala I

Meaning: He is in the form of Rudra and also Mahakaal i.e. he is the king of all the three time periods which include past, present and future.

Taap vimochan aridal naasa, Bhaal chandrama karahin prakasha I

Meaning: Because of them, Sun God provides us light and the Moon spreads light.

Shwet kaal aru laal shareera, Mastak mukut sheesh par cheera I

Meaning: In the White period his body is red in colour and he has a crown on his head.

Kali ke laala baladhaari, Kahaan tak shobha kahoan tumhaari I

Meaning: He is the son of Kali, that is, he is the lord of time and how can we describe his glory.

Shankar ke avataar kripaala, Raho chakachak pee mad pyaala I

Meaning: He is an incarnation of Lord Shankar who showers his blessings on all of us. He also remains happy by drinking a glass of liquor.

Shankar ke avataar kripaala, Batukanath chetak dikhaao I

Meaning: He is an incarnation of Lord Shankar who blesses all of us. O Batuknath!! Give us a glimpse of your form.

Ravi ke din jan bhog lagaaven, Dhoop deep naivedya chadhaven I

Meaning: On the day of Lord Sun i.e. Sunday, everyone offers incense, lamps and offerings to him.

Darshan karke bhakt sihaaven, Daaruda ki dhaar pilaaven I

Meaning: The devotees get pleasure just by seeing him and they all offer liquor to him.

Math mein sundar latakat jhaava, Siddh kary kar Bhairon Baba I

Meaning: They are beautiful and walk swingingly. O Bhairon Baba! Please fulfill all our tasks.

Nath aapka yash nahin thoda, Karmen subhag sushobhit koda I

Meaning: O Lord, your fame is no less than anyone else and even the whip looks beautiful in your hands.

Kati ghunghara surile bajaat, Kanchanmay sinhasan rajat I

Meaning: The bells on your feet ring with melodious music and you are seated on a throne of gold.

Nar naari sab tumko dhyaaven, Manvaanchhit ichchha phal paaven I

Meaning: Those men and women who meditate on you get the results as per their wishes.

Bhopa hain aapke pujari, Karen aarti seva bhaari I

Meaning: Bhopa is your priest who serves you and performs your aarti day and night.

Bhairav bhaat aapka gaaon, Baar baar pad sheesh navaaon I

Meaning: I sing bhaat of Bhairav Baba and bow my head at his feet again and again.

Aapahi vaare chhijan dhaaye, Ailadi ne rudan machaaye I

Meaning: Because of you, Aaladi lost everything and he started crying loudly.

Bahan tyagi bhai kahan jaave, To bin ko mohi bhaat pinhaave I

Meaning: The brother was extremely saddened by his sister's abandonment and he did not understand how he should fill the rice.

Roye Batukanath karuna kar, Gaye hivaare main tum jaakar I

Meaning: Then Aelaadi cried and pleaded before you and after that you went to her.

Dukhit bhai Ailadi baala, Tab har ka sinhasan haala I

Meaning: You reduced the sorrows of Aaladi brother and shook the throne of Har.

Samay byaah ka jis din aaya, Prabhu ne tumko turat pathaaya I

Meaning: The day the time of Aaladi's sister's marriage came, Bhairav Baba taught you a lesson.

Vishnu kahi mat vilamb lagao, Teen divas ko Bhairav jao I

Meaning: Lord Vishnu said that do not delay now and recite Bhairav Chalisa for three days.

Dal pathaan sang lekar dhaaya, Ailadi ko bhaat pinhaaya I

Meaning: When the groom's side along with their entire entourage arrived there, Ailaadi, with your blessings, organized the bhaat ceremony.

Pooran aas bahan ki keeni, Surkh chundari sir dhar deeni I

Meaning: Because of you, Eladi fulfilled all the hopes of his sister and covered her forehead with the wedding veil.

Bhaat bhara laut gaye Gungrami, Namu namaami antaryaami I

Meaning: All the villagers returned after having their rice. Oh Bhairav Baba!! You are omniscient, I bow to you.
