3. **Vasudeva** – Father of Shri Krishna, Lord of wealth.
4. **Sanatan** – Eternal or 'always lasting', that is, that which has no beginning and no end.
5. **Vasudevatomaja** – Son of Vasudeva
6. **Punya** - Very pure
7. **Leelamanush vigraha** – Presuming mankind to perform the past
8. **Srivatsa Kaustubhadharaya** – Sri Vatsa and Kaustubha wearing gems
9. **Yashodavatsal** – Beloved child of mother Yashoda
10. **Hari** – Lord of Nature
11. **Chaturbhujat Chakrasigada** – Four arms holding weapons.
