Meaning: [Lord Krishna](#) Wears A Beautiful Garland Of Flowers Around His Neck And Plays The Flute With Sweet And Melodious Tunes.

Shravan Mein Kundal Jhalakala, Nand Ke Anand Nandalala

Meaning: Beautiful Earrings Dangle From His Ears. Lord Krishna Is The Beloved Son Of Nand Baba.

Gagan Sam Ang Kaanti Kaali, Radhika Chamak Rahi Aali

Meaning: Lord Krishna's Complexion Is Dark Like The Sky, And Radha's Fair Complexion Shines Brilliantly Beside Him.

Latan Mein Thade Banmaali, Bhramar Si Alak, Kasturi Tilak, Chandra Si Jhalak, Lalit Chhavi Shyam Pyari Ki

Meaning: Lord Krishna Wears A Garland Made Of Many Forest Flowers. His Hair Curls Like A Bee, With A Musk Tilak On His Forehead, And His Appearance Is As Beautiful And Cool As The Moon, Creating The Most Enchanting Sight.

Kanakmay Mein Mor Mukut Bilase, Devta Darshan Ko Tarse

Meaning: Lord Krishna Wears A Crown Adorned With Peacock Feathers, And Even The Gods Yearn To See Him.

Gvalin Sang Atul Rati Gop Kumari Ki**

Meaning: Flowers Shower From The Sky, Murchang (A Musical Instrument) Plays, The Sweet Sound Of Mridang (A Drum) Is Heard, And The Gopis (Cowherd Girls) Are Present, All Creating An Incomparable Scene.

Jahan Te Prakat Bhai Ganga, Sakal Man Harini Shri Ganga

Meaning: From Where The Ganges River Emerged, That Place Is The Abode Of Lord Krishna, Who Brings Peace To All Hearts.

Charan Chhavi Shribanwari Ki**

Meaning: Just Remembering Lord Krishna Can Free One From Illusions. The Ganges, Residing In The Matted Hair Of Lord Shiva, Washes The Feet Of Lord Krishna, Dispelling All Impurities.

Chamakti Ujjwal Tat Renu, Baj Rahi Vrindavan Benu

Meaning: The Banks Of The Ganges Shine Brightly, And The Sweet Sound Of The Flute Can Be Heard In Vrindavan.
