Let us explore the *Chalisa* of Lord Chandra, whose recitation brings the blessings of the Moon God.

Jai Jai Chandra Amar Nath. Jai Jai Jayat Sut Gun Gath.

**Meaning:** Hail to Amar Nath Chandra (the Moon God). Hail, hail, and praise be to the son and his virtues.

|| Chaupais ||

#### 1. Jai Jai Jai Chandra Bhagwana. Saptashat Bhoomi Teri Mana.

**Meaning:** Hail, hail, hail to Lord Chandra. Your domain is considered to be seven hundred in measure.

2. Shwet Kiran Karuna Ke Sagar. Sheetalta De Man Ko Ujagar. **Meaning:** Your white rays are an ocean of compassion, providing coolness and enlightenment to the mind.

#### 3. Vashistha Tujhe Dev Man Mana. Som Shreshtha Tujhse Hi Jana.

**Meaning:** Sage Vashistha recognizes you as a deity, and the excellence of the Moon (Som) is known through you.

#### 4. Amrit Mayi Rashmi Teri Pyari. Sheetalta De Jagat Sanwari.

**Meaning:** Your nectar-like rays are beloved and adorn the world with their soothing effect.

#### 5. Dwijpati Kahe Tujhe Muni Gyani. Chandra Rashi Mein Tu Maha Prani.

**Meaning:** The learned and wise call you the king of the twice-born (Brahmins), and you are a great being within the lunar constellation.

#### 6. Dev Danav Tujhe Sheesh Nawawe. Tera Poojan Shanti Dilave.

Meaning: Gods and demons bow to you, and worshipping you brings peace.

#### 7. Sompriya Priyapati Tera. Jyotishiyon Ne Tu Hi Ghera.

Meaning: Beloved of the Moon, you are the focus of astrologers.

#### 8. Shwetambar Dhari Karun Nidhi. Teri Mahima Atulit Nidhi.

**Meaning:** You, the bearer of white garments, are a treasure of compassion. Your glory is immeasurable.

#### 9. Vrat Somvar Tujhe Prasann Kare. Tujhse Jeevan Dhanya Bhare.

Meaning: The Monday fast pleases you, and your grace fills life with blessings.

#### 10. Shwet Varn Ki Tu Jyoti. Tujhse Milta Nit Shanti.

**Meaning:** You are the light of the white color, and through you, eternal peace is obtained.

#### 11. Chandra Kiran Sjeev Ko Poshe. Jal Ko Bhi Tujhse Hi Josh.

Meaning: Your moonbeams nourish the living and imbue water with vitality.

#### 12. Sharad Purnima Mein Teri Mahima. Tujhse Hi Ho Srishti Ki Garima.

**Meaning:** Your glory shines during Sharad Purnima, and through you, the splendor of creation is maintained.

#### 13. Chandra Dosh Ka Kar Tu Nivaran. Tere Bina Na Ho Koi Sakshar.

**Meaning:** You remove the defects of the moon, and without you, nothing would be complete.

#### 14. Chandra Grahasti Ka Kar Har Nivaran. Tujhse Milta Sabko Uddharan.

**Meaning:** You remove the effects of lunar eclipses, and through you, everyone finds salvation.

#### 15. Sompriya Jo Tujhe Niharen. Unka Sankat Tu Hi Tare.

**Meaning:** O beloved of the Moon, those who gaze upon you have their troubles removed.

#### 16. Chandra Dharan Kar Shiv Shankar. Neelkanth Ka Roop Sanware.

**Meaning:** Lord Shiva bears the moon and appears in the form of Neelkanth (the Blue-Throated One).

#### 17. Tujhe Arpan Jal Dhara. Dukhon Ka Kart Tu Nivaran.

Meaning: We offer you the stream of water, and you alleviate our sorrows.

#### 18. Chandramayi Dhara Tujhe Dhyaven. Sagar Bhi Tujhse Jud Javen.

Meaning: The Moon-like earth worships you, and the ocean connects with you.

#### 19. Chandra Kiran Tujhe Nit Vandana. Tujhse Hi Ho Jeevan Vandana.

Meaning: We constantly worship the moonbeams, and through you, life is honored.

#### 20. Jyotishiyon Ki Tu Rakwala. Teri Mahima Atulit Pyala.

**Meaning:** You are the protector of astrologers, and your glory is like an incomparable chalice.

#### 21. Jal Ke Bhi Tu Hi Rakwala. Srishti Ka Tu Hi Sambhala.

Meaning: You are the guardian of water, and you manage the creation.

#### 22. Chandra Se Shanti Ka Mel. Tujhse Hi Jeevan Ka Khel.

**Meaning:** Peace comes from the moon, and through you, life's play is maintained.

#### 23. Chandra Kiran Ki Mahima Nyari. Sagar Bhi Tujhse Hi Pyari.

**Meaning:** The glory of moonbeams is unique, and the ocean too is dear because of you.

#### 24. Tera Poojan Phaldayi Ho. Dukh-Daridra Na Sataaye Ho.

**Meaning:** May worshipping you be fruitful, and may one be free from suffering and poverty.

#### 25. Chandra Darshan Sukha De Bhari. Dukhiyon Ki Karte Tu Sanwari.

Meaning: Viewing the moon brings immense joy, and you assist those in distress.

#### 26. Jinke Sir Par Tera Haath. Unke Paas Na Ho Koi Anath.

Meaning: Those under your protection never have anyone abandoned.

#### 27. Karuna Teri Sada Sheetal. Tera Poojan Jag Mein Amrital.

**Meaning:** Your compassion is always soothing, and your worship is like nectar in the world.

#### 28. Chandra Devta Sabko Tare. Sankat Se Sabki Raksha Kare.

Meaning: The Moon God guides everyone and protects all from difficulties.

#### 29. Tere Poojan Se Ho Santosh. Sankaton Ka Hove Nash.

**Meaning:** Worshipping you brings satisfaction, and it eliminates all troubles.

#### 30. Sompriya Jo Vrat Rakhe. Sankat Se Wo Sab Raksha Kare.

**Meaning:** O beloved of the Moon, those who observe the fast are protected from all troubles.

#### 31. Chandramayi Tujhse Ho Tej. Tujhse Jeevan Ka Ho Gage.

**Meaning:** Through your moonlight, life gains brilliance and measures up to greatness.

#### 32. Shwet Pushp Se Ho Tera Poojan. Tujhse Hi Door Ho Jeevan Srijan.

**Meaning:** Worship with white flowers is done, and through you, life's creation is sustained.

#### 33. Sompriya Ka Tu Rakwala. Tujhse Hi Ho Jeevan Ka Pala.

**Meaning:** O beloved of the Moon, you are the guardian of life, and through you, life is protected.

#### 34. Chandramayi Tu Kar Kripa. Tujhse Ho Jeevan Ki Srijan Dhara.

**Meaning:** O Moon Goddess, please grant your grace, as life's creative flow comes from you.

#### 35. Sompriya Teri Aarti Gaye. Sankaton Ka Har Nivaran Paaye.

Meaning: Those who sing your aarti (hymn) find solutions to all their problems.

#### 36. Chandramayi Tujhse Hi Nihare. Tujhse Hi Ho Jeevan Ki Sab Pyari.

Meaning: Those who gaze upon you find everything in life dear through you.

#### 37. Chandramayi Dhara Ko Jo Jaane. Tujhse Hi Srishti Ki Suhane.

**Meaning:** Those who understand the Moon-like earth find the creation beautiful through you.

38. Chandra Ki Mahima Atulit. Tujhse Hi Ho Jeevan Ki Shakti.

Meaning: The glory of the moon is unparalleled, and life's strength comes from you.

#### 39. Chandra Se Ho Jeevan Mein Ujala. Tujhse Hi Ho Jeevan Ka Pyala.

Meaning: Light in life comes from the moon, and through you, life's cup is filled.

#### 40. Tujhse Srishti Ka Srijan Ho. Tujhse Hi Jeevan Ka Pavan Ho.

**Meaning:** Through you, creation happens, and through you, the breath of life is sustained.

This *Chalisa* is a worship of Lord Chandra (the Moon God) and an expression of the benefits provided by him. Reciting it regularly brings mental peace, prosperity, and happiness.

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
