Ya Kundendu Tushar Haar Dhavala, Ya Shubhra Vastravrita I

Meaning: The goddess who is white like the jasmine flower and the moon, and who is adorned with white garments.

Ya Veena Varadanda Manditakara Ya Shvetapadmasana I

Meaning: The goddess who holds a veena (musical instrument) in her hand, grants knowledge and blessings, and who is seated on a white lotus.

Ya Brahmachyuta Shankara Prabhrutibhir Devaih Sada Vandita I

Meaning: The goddess who is always worshipped by gods like Brahma, Vishnu, and Shiva.

Sa Maam Paatu Saraswati Bhagwati Nihshesh Jaadyapaha I

Meaning: We pray to that same goddess Saraswati to free us from all ignorance and foolishness.

Shuklaam Brahmavichar Saaraparamam Adyaam Jagadvyapineem I

Meaning: The goddess who is clothed in white garments, is the essence of Brahma's knowledge, the primal power, and who pervades the entire universe.

Veena-Pustak-Dharinim Abhayadam Jaadyandhakarapaham I

Meaning: The goddess who holds a veena and a book, who destroys fear, and dispels ignorance and darkness.

Haste Sphatikamalikaam Vidhadhateem Padmaasane Sansthitaam I

Meaning: The goddess who holds a crystal garland in her hand and is seated on a lotus.

Vande Taam Parameshwari Bhagwati Buddhipradaam Sharadam I

Meaning: I bow to that supreme goddess Bhagwati Saraswati, who is the giver of wisdom and the goddess of knowledge.

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
