- Chant the Surya Gayatri Mantra:
"Om Adityaya Vidmahe Divakaraya Dhimahi Tannah Suryah Prachodayat."

Significance of Donations

Donating sesame seeds, jaggery, food grains, clothes, and money on this day is believed to bring immense spiritual merit. Donations of sesame and jaggery, in particular, are said to promote health and prosperity.

Observing Fasts and Rituals

If possible, observe a fast and consume only fruits. Eat only sattvic food and refrain from anger or negative emotions.

Special Havan

Some devotees organize special havans (fire rituals) where sesame seeds and jaggery are offered. This is believed to spread positive energy in the home.
