- ❖ **Sarvavahanavahana** – One who sits on all vehicles

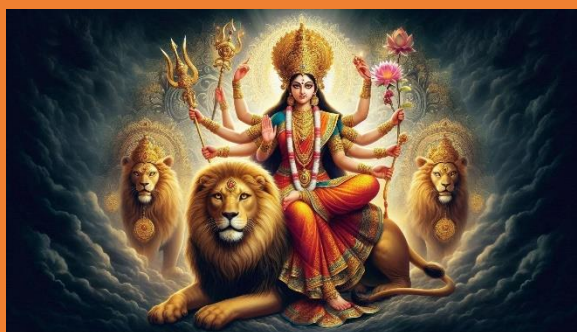


- ❖ **Nishumbhashumbhahanani** – The slayer of Shumbh and Nishumbh

- ❖ **Muktakeshi** – One with open hair

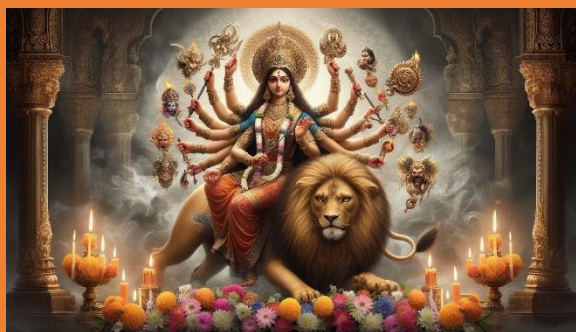


- ❖ **Ghorrupa** – One with a fierce attitude
