Procedure for Maa Lakshmi Puja

1. Preparation:

Wake up early on the day of the puja, take a bath, and wear clean clothes.

Clean the puja area, spread a cloth, and place the picture or idol of Maa Lakshmi.

2. Begin with Ganesh Puja:

Start the puja by worshiping Lord Ganesha to remove any obstacles. Offer him laddus, modaks, and flowers.

3. Worship Maa Lakshmi:

What to Do in the Puja Procedure:

- Ganesh Worship: Worship Lord Ganesh and take a vow for the fast.
- Worship Maa Lakshmi: Offer flowers, lamps, and incense sticks to the picture or idol of Maa Lakshmi.
- Mantra Chanting: Recite "Om Mahalakshmyai Namah" and "Shri Sukta.
- Aarti: Light a lamp and perform the aarti for Maa Lakshmi, moving the lamp in all four directions.
- Offer Food: Present sweets and fruits, and distribute prasad.
- Prayers: Pray to Maa Lakshmi for wealth, happiness, and prosperity.

What Not to Do in the Puja Procedure:

- Avoid Obstacles in Worship: Do not let any obstacles arise during the puja.
- Avoid Dirt or Impurity: Do not keep dirt or impurities in the puja area or your clothing.
- **Negativity:** Avoid negative thoughts and anger during the puja.
- Avoid Negative Thoughts: Steer clear of disputes, arguments, or any other negative activities during the worship.













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
