Vibhuwan Sankashti Chaturthi is a sacred Hindu fasting festival dedicated to Lord Ganesha, the remover of obstacles and the giver of wisdom and prosperity. Vibhuwan Sankashti Chaturthi Puja Vidhi

Follow these steps to perform the puja correctly:

1. Morning Purification

Wake up early, take a bath, and wear clean clothes. Take a vow (Sankalp) to observe the fast with devotion.

2. Prepare the Puja Area

Clean the worship area and place an idol or image of Lord Ganesha on a decorated altar.



3. Offer Sacred Items

Offer the following items to Lord Ganesha:

- Durva grass
- Red flowers
- Kumkum and sandalwood paste
- Akshat (uncooked rice)
- Modak or laddoo
- Incense sticks and oil lamps

4. Chant Mantras

Recite Ganesha mantras, Ganesh Chalisa, and Sankashti Chaturthi Vrat Katha with devotion.

5. Observe the Fast

Many devotees observe a Nirjala fast (without water), while others consume fruits and milk throughout the day.

6. Moon Worship

In the evening, after moonrise, offer water (Arghya) to the Moon God and then perform Lord Ganesha's aarti before breaking the fast.

Vibhuwan Sankashti Chaturthi Vrat Katha

According to Hindu scriptures, Lord Ganesha blesses those who observe Sankashti Chaturthi with faith and devotion.





It is believed that many kings, sages, and devotees attained success and freedom from hardships by observing this vrat. The vrat katha emphasizes devotion, patience, and unwavering faith in Lord Ganesha.

Listening to or reading the Vrat Katha on this day is considered highly auspicious and enhances the spiritual benefits of the fast.
